The FACE Child & Adolescent Risk Assessment Suite (CARAS) is the UK's first fully integrated suite of risk assessment tools and outcome measures for use in child and adolescent mental health services.

Evidence-based

Uses a systematic and structured approach to assess static and dynamic risk factors. This supports clinicians by identifying key risk factors that are used to formulate and implement risk management plans.

Supports planning

All information recorded feeds into risk management plans, leading to more targeted care and improving efficiency.

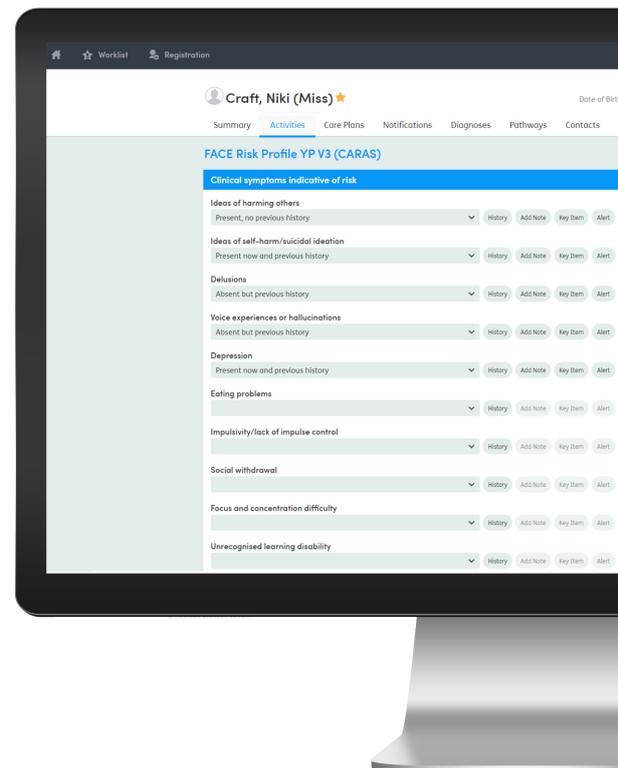
Supports multi-disciplinary teams

The capacity to include community teams, specialist teams, forensic services, learning disabilities, eating disorders, and secure inpatient services has been integrated using evidence-based methodologies over a two-year period.

The CARAS is appropriate for use within multidisciplinary teams where clinicians and staff of varying professional backgrounds and skills are working together.
